





"The owner of a dog which bites a person when the

person is in or on a public place or lawfully in or on a

private place, including the property of the owner of

the dog, is liable for damages suffered by the person

bitten, regardless of the former viciousness of the


dog or the owner's knowledge of its viciousness."

Comparative Fault

Defendants may use A.R.S. 11-1027

* A.R.S. 11-1025

or reasonable provocation as defense The owner may not be held liable if the victim provoked the dog to attack or bite.
